Not only did I have a health scare, but Dee was hospitalized on Mother's Day weekend in Port St. Lucie, Florida. Doctors determined she was having a flare up of a past neck and back injury. Thank God she is feeling better. The traveling we do can be exacting on the body! But what a thrill it is to us to see the change God can and will make in a life.

We have presented Victory Baptist Press to 38 different churches this year. The Lord has given 14 rolls of paper through churches and individuals for the ministry. PRAISE BE TO OUR GOD!

God has allowed us six new supporting ministries. Our year has already taken us around the world from Africa to Florida, Arizona, and New Mexico.

At the time of this writing, Dee and I are in flight, coming back from a full weekend in Glendale, Arizona. We have had a wonderful weekend with Pastor Greg Hardesty of Western Hills Baptist Church. The church folks were great hosts; they purchased two rolls of paper for the Press and blessed us by also taking us on for monthly support!

June 5 finds us on the road to begin a mission conference in Missouri. By the end of June, Lord willing, we will take a lengthy northeastern trip into Pennsylvania, New Jersey, New York, Virginia, and then North Carolina. Please continue to keep us in prayer.

Our ministry just finished 25,000 Spanish Bibles and has begun shipping them out. Our workers at VBP are working daily to keep the office and presses running. There is a great and pressing need for Scripture around the world. We thank each of you for your faithful support. It is only God's grace and your prayers and financial support that grant us the privilege to do what we do.
