Most of Sister Karen's work for the next three months will be making sure all the emails are answered and all the printed material for the Million Signature Campaign for Joshua and Caleb Thompson is taken care of. We are in the planning stage of putting my office in our home, but until then I will work whereever I can find a place to turn the computer on.

I suppose I could word this in such a way so that our readers would think Sister Karen has kicked me out of the office, and they'd feel sorry for me or think that I was really sacrificing to make room for another worker, but since I am on the road in meetings a lot of the time anyway it works out

best for me to have all of my work inside the laptop.

A few weeks back I was in Salt Lake City, Utah, a dry and thirsty land, not only physically but spiritually. Dear Friends and Supporters,

The last few months have found us busy as usual in the print shop. Our most recent project to be completed was a set of six thousand Russian New Testament signatures to be put together by East European Harvest in Mobile, Alabama. This is the organization, that through a series of unfortunate events was not able to use the Mueller Martini bindery system they had purchased several years ago, and they ended up giving it to us. They still have volunteers putting books together by hand and using a much smaller glue binder, so it was our privilege to print a few thousand New Testaments for them. They also get them out on the mission field at no cost to the missionaries they send them to.

Our next project on the big press will be to print about 24,000 Spanish New Testaments. This project has been in the making for a long time, and it will be a blessing to finally get it going. Please pray that we get them done soon and that there will be many more to follow.

Also, in between other duties that we have in the shop, we have been helping Bro. Miza Oliveira learn how to print. He is a native Brazilian who moved to the Baltimore, Maryland, area to marry his bride, who he originally met in Brazil. (She had gone there on a church mission trip.) While living there, he got involved in a printing ministry and saw some requests for literature to go to Brazil. Because of the shipping expenses it is very difficult to get any large quantities of material into Brazil. So, God laid it on his heart to go back to Brazil and print there. His pastor in Maryland recommended that he spend some time with us to learn how to print, and he moved his wife and three children here in March of this year. Already, God has given him an electrostatic plate maker, an AB Dick 360 press in good condition, and a 30 pocket booklet maker with saddle stitcher and folder. The only other piece of equipment he needs now to make a complete print shop is a paper cutter. Bro. Miza has

dreams of needing much larger equipment some day, but this will be a good start for a new print shop. Bro. Miza is a very humble brother who is willing to do anything he is able. When he says he will clean the toilets if that is what is needed, he means it. Please pray that God will honor Bro. Miza's burden and establish a printing ministry in the country of Brazil.

Please continue to pray for all of us in the shop, but especially for Bro. Bill Roberts at this time. He recently had surgery on his colon to remove a cancerous polyp. During the surgery, the surgeon removed several lymph nodes and a few of them tested positive for cancer as well. So, now he has begun six months of chemotherapy and will have about a month of radiation treatments after that. Please pray that the treatments will be successful and that he will be able to return to the shop. In the mean time, Bro Starling and myself will try to hold down the fort. When he first came on board a little over a year ago, he told people it was his calling to give me a hard time. He found out I was a little harder nut to crack than he thought and is starting to wonder if he missed God's calling for his life! Please pray for both



Right in the middle of showing the inspector how to be saved, the pilot returned to the airplane. While we were sitting there showing the scriptures to the inspector the pilot excused himself and started checking any and everything on the plane. He kept looking very busy until the inspector prayed and asked God to save him and forgive him of all his sins. After the inspector prayed and got his life right he looked different. Myself, I no longer felt sick.

Praise the Lord for Juanita helping and U.I.M. Aviation for having good pilots and mechanics to help us in our prison services.


Because she works with children who have so little and have been through the tortures and agonies of a country beset with re-







Pastor Tim Fellure

The Love of God I John 4:19

The apostle Paul speaks of the "breadth, and length, and depth, and height" of the love of God – it is such an immeasurable and incomprehensible subject that the preacher struggles with knowing how to approach it. A similar problem is in knowing that when you have said all you can say about the love of God, there will be more left unsaid than what you were able to give. The best of sermons can only touch the hem of God's love to men.

When I state that God loves me it is a truth of which I am fully convinced. I have doubted God's will and ways, I have questioned His wisdom in the circumstances of life, I have wondered about His willingness to answer my prayer, but I have never doubted God's love for me. There has never been a time in my life, whether in good times of bad, that it could be suggested that I was not loved. You could never convince of anything less. The devil has whispered in my ear that God didn't care for me, but his words have always fallen on deaf ears.

The reason I know this so assuredly is because God has told me He loves me. The love of God is something that can be inferred by the many things God has done for us, but He does not leave it to an inference. Rather, He has declared His love and recorded it in His eternal Word. I do not surmise that God loves me from the works of creation; I read it where He declared emphatically that His love was toward me. I know He loves me because He told me He loved me.

Another reason I know God loves me is because He has not just said it, but He has shown it. The demonstrations of His love toward me are too numerous to count:

I have infallible and irrefutable proof that God loves me because of the way He has dealt with me. Only a God of love would bestow so many blessings on one's life. Only a God of love would forgive so many sins. Only a God of love would receive the prodigal again after so many times of wandering away. It may not be evident that I love Him, but look at my life, and you will have to say that somebody loves me.

1.) The Love of God is First!

"We love him, because he first loved us." It is such a simple statement, but it is the essence of the love of God. The love of God to us precedes our love to God. God loved me before there was anything in me to love. I should have been seeking the love of God, trying to compel Him to love me. But instead He sought my love, compelling me to love Him.

Before I ever repented of my sin, God loved me. Before I ever exercised faith in Christ, God loved me. Before I opened my heart to the gospel, before I believed the witness of the Holy Spirit, before I accepted the sacrifice of Calvary for my pardon – God loved me. There are many things about you now that God could love, but they were not there at the first. You may be very devoted to Christ, but you were not so before God loved you. You may have a high degree of holiness in your life, but you were loved when you were unholy. You may be conformed in many ways to the image of Christ, but God loved you when that image was not there. No matter how early in life you began to love the Lord, His love was first.

There was no reason in me for God to exercise His love for me. When He looked at me He found no grounds for love, but the reason was in His own nature. But what does that mean? It means that the love of God is uncreated; therefore, it is unchangeable. If the love of God is seated in His character and not mine, then His character would have to change for Him not to love me. If God loved me because of what I had done or because of some good He saw in me, then I would have to keep that good thing to keep the love of God. But God loved me because it was His nature to love the unlovable. If God loved me because I was good, then when the goodness diminished the love would diminish, as well. But God loved me because He was good, and His goodness will never diminish.

2.) The Love of God is Firm!

Since I have known the love of God I have given Him ten thousand excuses not to love me any longer. Yet, in spite of all my ill manners, shortcomings and transgressions, coldness of heart and backsliding, He still loves me. He loved me when I was unlovable so that He could make me into something lovable. But so many times I have done like Gomer and spurned the love of God. I have been everything but lovely and holy, yet even then God still loves me.

I did not earn His love in the beginning, and I do not keep His love by my own righteousness. He may not be pleased with me, but He will always love me. He may not bless me more abundantly if I stray from His will, but He will always love me. There have been times I have been out of His will, but I have never been out of His care.

The love of God is without beginning and it is without pause. There is never a moment when God does not love me. It is without break from beginning to end; a single chain without a weak link to risk it breaking. It knows no seasons, it has no intermission, there is no hint of failure or an end to the love of God.

3.) The Love of God is Full!

I am happy to say that I love the Lord now more than I ever have before, but I cannot say that He now loves me more than ever before. My love for Him is so much deeper – the more I learn of Him the more I love Him. But God loved me as fully as He could love me from the very beginning. He knew all there was to know about me yet He loved me from the very beginning with all the love of His heart. He cannot love me more, and He will not love me less. Nor is there any of you that God loves more than He loves me. You may love the Lord more than I love Him, but He does not love you more than He loves me.

There have been times when I did not love Him like I should, but there has never been a time when He did not love me with all His heart. There has never been a time when God did not love you as much as He loves you right now. You may at this day be at the your very lowest – it may be that you have strayed farther away from God now than ever before – but God loves you as much as when you were the closest to Him. It may seem like your life is ruined, that everyone is loved but you, and that you are a miserable wretch that no one could possibly love, but God loves you.
