



JAMES NAUDI NATIONAL PREACHER FROM THE KAMEA TRIBE

I had the privilege this past Friday evening of taking missionary John Allen and Brother James Naudi, a national preacher from the Kamea Tribe of the Gulf Province of Papua, New Guinea to the Ryans Steak House for dinner. On Sunday morning I had the unique privilege of praying at the altar with Brother James. Missionary Matt Allen brought Brother James to the states for a visit and to be a testimony of what the mission work in New Guinea has accomplished.

Brother Matt said when they were about two hours into their twenty-five hour flight, that Brother James looked out the air plane window at that vast and beautiful South Pacific Ocean they were flying over and said, iBrother Matt, this is a BIG world.î About twenty hours later as they began nearing the end of their flight Brother James said iBrother Matt, we have a BIG God.î

There are about 40,000 people in the Kamea tribe that Brother James is from, and

none of them have a Bible in their language. In fact, they have no literature at all because their language has never been written. Missionary John Allen is presently doing his deputation in preparation for the translation work among the Kamean tribe. It will be a long hard task, but as Brother James said, we have a BIG God.

UPGRADING OF EOUIPMENT

Two years ago when we got the Muller Martini bindery system, the trimmer that does the final trimming of the books before they are boxed for shipping gave us some problems. We checked with the company that services that particular machine and found that it has to be upgraded to a computerized system. The cost for the upgrade is \$9,500. Until we can afford this change, we are trimming all of the books on a single blade cutter. Please help us pray in the money to repair this piece of very important equipment.

MISSIONARY ANTONIO ARELLANOS NEEDS A HOUSE

Brother Antonio Arellanos has definitely used his mission support for the ministry. He has started six very successful independent Baptist churches (many times paying the pastoris salary out of his own personal support) and a medical clinic, but he has never owned a home of his own. He has lived in an upstairs apartment for twenty-one years, and his wife Angela (Missionary Sonny Fritzí daughter), has arthritis so bad that it hurts to go up and down the stairs, but I have never one time heard him or his family complain. While I was in Monterrey, Mexico the first week in April, the Lord burdened my heart to raise the money to get this good missionary family into a decent house. The total amount for the house is \$30,000. Our home church has already committed for \$15,000 leaving me to raise the additional \$15,000. Please pray that the Lord will give me enough

Dear Friends and Supporters,

While waiting for paper to be delivered we have been doing some pre-press work on the computer. We printed the first run of the Rheina Valara Gomez 2004 edition of the Spanish New Testament last year and have tried to put it out to as many different brethren as possible to get some feedback on it, and the response has been overwhelmingly positive. As was expected though, there were a few typos and a few other minor changes that have been made since then, so all that will need to be laid

out again. I just recently finished doing all the layout work for a new Romanian New Testament. The old translation had some gross errors in it, and it was hard for missionaries and preachers to preach from it. Now we need some 38" paper to print that on.

As far as paper goes, we have been searching for several weeks for paper and hoping to print the Romanian New Testament and the RVG Spanish New Testament, but it has been very difficult to find, however we did come up with some 34.5" and 35" paper that we will print some John/Romans on. (We print the John/ Romans a slightly smaller size since they are used more for mass distribution on the streets by missionaries and are a little easier to handle that way.) We will be printing in English (it has been a long time since we have done any John/Romans in English), Telegu (a language used in India), and Spanish. Please pray that we can get these out quickly and find a truckload of 38" paper so we can do the New Testaments as well.

Our new print shop is now in the waiting stage. Plans have been submitted to an engineer, and then permits must be obtained before anything can get started on the ground. Pray that all that goes as smoothly as possible.

Miza Oliveira is in Brazil at this time searching for property on which to put his new print shop and home. He will also be taking a trip up into the Amazon region with some other missionaries while he is there. Miza is willing to build a building for his print shop, but I am praying that he will find a suitable one already built that he can purchase so that he can get started printing faster. He already has a 40' container loaded with mostly printing equipment. His wife is begging for a little space for some household items as well. When he comes back to the States, he will be hitting the road full-time raising money for the printing ministry in Brazil.

Please pray for all the printing ministries you may know of. There is a tremendous need around the world for all kinds of good material. I have been at it, one way or another since 1985, and I am still learning new and better ways to get things done. Thank God for that!

The Lord is so gracious to allow us to have a part in the ministry of providing gospel literature to those who have not heard the good news of Jesus Christ and His gift of salvation. May we never take for granted this opportunity of serving the Master.



Jairus And His Daughter

Luke 8:41-56

I have preached a number of times from the story of Jairus and his daughter, but always with the miracle as my topic. His story, along with the case of the woman with the issue of blood, is good preaching material if you want to brag on what Jesus can do in a familyís life. However, this week I read the story again with Jairus himself in mind. As I contemplated him I was impressed with three specific attitudes of Jairus.

1) His Concern For His Child!

The scriptures tell us that Jairus was the ruler of the synagogue. This implies that he was a very important person and surely quite busy. He would be the administrator or overseer of the local synagogue where he lived. He managed the business affairs and was responsible for conducting the services, and would have been one of the most respected men in the community. But it is not the synagogue that he is concerned about. He has forgotten all about his duties as a ruler and has nothing but the health of his daughter in mind. He is an important and busy man who is not too important and busy to be a dad. His daughter is sick and nothing is more important to him just now than getting help for his only child. That impresses me!

God give us men who will carry a burden for their children. And in all your

concerns, be more concerned about their spiritual well-being than anything else. I would rather my sons and daughter love God and serve Him more than anything I could wish for. The #1 desire of my life is to see my children walk in truth.

Some fathers dream of their kid becoming a professional ball-player. Others dream of their kid becoming a multimillionaire and president of some fine corporation. Others even dream of their kid rising in politics to possibly even becoming the President of the United States. The dream I have for my kids is that they love God with all their heart.

What our homes need are some mommas who know how to weep and beg heaven for her children. What our homes need are some fathers who know how to fast and pray and grab the horns of the altar until God blesses our children. What our homes need is a church that keeps a hot pulpit and the altars wet with tears on behalf of our children.

2) His Confidence In Christ!

Jairus got news that Jesus was passing through his town and he determined that he would not let Him pass without a healing touch for his daughter. The fame of Jesus had spread and Jairus knew the stories of all the miracles people were claiming He had done. Jairus seemed to believe that all he needed to do was get Jesus to his house and his daughter would be helped. He had complete trust that Christ was all she needed.

But you need to remember that Jairus was a ruler of the synagogue which means he was one of the chief religious men of that region. And we know that the religious elders of that day had no use for Jesus. As a religious ruler, Jairus would have considered Jesus a heretic and blasphemer. But someone had convinced him that Jesus could heal his daughter. And he was willing to abandon his religious prejudices, endure the scorn of his colleagues, and humble himself before the Lord to get Christ to his daughter.

I too have confidence that if you can

get your children to God, they will be alright. Our children are going to face pressures we know nothing about and they need a close relationship with their Savior. Just get your children to Jesus!

3) His Commitment to The Cure!

If you read through the story too fast you will miss the fact that Jairus faced great obstacles on his way to Jesus. It would have been easy to get discouraged and even have quit, but he would not stop until his daughter was made whole.

The first obstacle Jairus ran into was a woman. Jairus had reached Jesus and was leading him to his home when Jesus was stopped by a woman touching him. Now Jairus surely would not resent Jesus healing this woman, but time is critical. This woman will make it another day ñ her disease is not life threatening. But Jairusí daughter is sick unto death.

Then while Jairus is forced to wait while Jesus deals with this woman, a servant from his house comes with the terrible news that his daughter has just passed away. While a woman bothers Jesus, his daughter dies. Now it is no use for Jesus to come to his house. It is too late to help now! But Jesus insists on going anyway. And when he gets there he prompts laughter from those in the house when he declares the daughter is only sleeping. And though they would not laugh at Jairus in his grief, he bears the reproach of having Jesus in his home.

Jairus would see a great miracle in his home that day but not without facing some great obstacles. He had to face the delay of Christ, the doubts of his own mind when they told him his daughter had died, and the derision of those in his home at the idea that she was not dead.

And you too can expect great opposition as well to your home. It will take a great commitment to the cause to succeed in raising kids for God. But seeing your children serve God will be worth every trial you must face. Getting your children to Jesus will be worth any sacrifice you must make. Just ask Jairus!
