It's been said that, "To live up above with all those we love, oh, that will be glory. But to live down below with all those we know, now that's a different story." Another would say, "This world would not be so bad if it were not for the people in it." I once heard of a little boy who sprinkled a little bit of raunchy cheese into his grandfather's mustache while he slept. When grandfather awoke he smelled the cheese and thought the room stunk. He went into the living room and found that it stunk also. He went into the kitchen and found that the kitchen stunk. He went to every room in the house and concluded that the whole house stunk. He went outside to try and get away from the foul odor, and there exclaimed, "The whole world stinks." John said in 1 John 5:19, "And we know that we are of God, and the whole world lieth in wickedness." To say the least, this world is not a friend of grace.

Our society is in bad shape and the political world doesn't seem to be helping much. Will Rogers once said, "Our Congress is not much, but it is the best money can buy."

We are also suffering drastically from the loss of a dear friend. Someone recently sent me the following announcement:

It looks like this year will be another record-breaking year for scripture printing.

STATEMENT OF FAITH

We accept the Holy Scriptures contained in the Old and New Testaments as being the verbally inspired Word of God and being perfectly preserved in the King James 1611 Bible. We do not believe it can be corrected or improved upon in any way. It is the final rule of faith and practice.

We believe in the deity of Christ – His virgin birth, His sinless life, His death for the sins of the world, His bodily resurrection, His exaltation at God's right hand, His personal, imminent, and premillennial return.

WE BELIEVE all men are sinners and are guilty before God; in need of a Saviour.

We believe that men are born again through repentance and faith in Jesus Christ; that they become the children of God, eternally saved; that the Holy Spirit dwells within every believer to guide and help him in his testimony and service.

WE BELIEVE in the bodily resurrection of the just and the unjust, the everlasting blessedness of the saved in Glory, and the everlasting conscious punishment of the lost in hell. We believe that all believers have a responsibility to get the Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ into all the world.

The BAND OF 200 program has already given some extra financial help needed to keep the big press running. Since implementing the program the first of January we have raised about 25% of the total need. Another one hundred and seventy-five supporters, at \$100 per month, will complete the band and provide all the paper we could run through the big press in a year.

Dear Friends and Supporters,

There was not room in the last issue of the Newsletter for my notes, and we did not put one out in January, so it has been a while since I have had a chance to keep you updated on what is going on in the shop here in Milton, Florida. We received a truckload of paper early in January and were glad to get the big press rolling again. This truckload will be all New Testaments.

The first batch we did was 15,000 Spanish New Testaments with the new cover that Bro. Grainger, a graphic artist God has blessed our church with, designed. It is the first full-color job that we have printed in our shop and on a single color Multi-lith 1850. That means that each cover had to go through the press four times. That means we have four chances to mess it up, but by the grace of God, they came out very well. Although there is always room for improvement, everybody seems to like them. The point of this is not to have bragging rights, but "to adorn the gospel of the grace of God." If an attractive cover

will make someone pick up a copy of the word of God and read, it who otherwise would not have, then it is all worth the trouble.

Another project that has been waiting for a long time is the Tagalog New Testament for the Philippine Islands. We recently finished printing about 15,000 copies and are currently working on putting them together.

We plan on finishing up this truckload with another project that has been on hold for quite some time, the Portuguese New Testament. There should be enough paper left to print about 18,000 of them.

We have prayed for a long time for 38" wide paper to print New Testaments on and we are thankful to have found some, but now the problem is reversed. When we were printing John/Romans, we had no New Testaments. Now that we are printing New Testaments, the need for John/Romans has not lessened in the least, and we currently do not have any in stock. Since we know that we can not fulfill every request, please pray that God will give us wisdom on which projects to take on and which to leave off. It is not an easy decision.

A special thanks is due this month to the Jenson's and the Racette's. Both of these are retired couples who have given up their homes and travel full-time in RVs helping various ministries. Bro. Racette has been with us one time before and is mechanically gifted. He was a real help with some much needed maintenance and repair on some of our machinery. The Jenson's stayed about two months and collated scriptures every day and kept us busy trying to keep up with them.

Please continue to pray for us in the shop. As long as I have been at this, about 18 years now one way or another, nothing ever seems to come easy. I know that most of this is because of my ignorance, and I have learned most of what I do know the hard way, which some say is the best way, but I am also aware that Satan is not happy with anyone printing the word of God. I do not really believe that he enters into the machinery and paper, but I do believe he messes with my mind sometimes in simple ways, like letting me forget to do a normally routine thing causing things to mess up; or dropping a screw and not being able to find it for 45 minutes. I am thankful that there has been no serious injuries in the shop from the beginning. Please pray that God will continue to bless Victory Baptist Press and that He will let it grow as He sees fit.




HOW GOOD AND HOW PLEASANT!

Miracles At Calvary

Matthew 27:45-54

This is the darkest day in the history of the world. Never has there been a day as this – the day the Son of God was crucified. Humanity has never stooped as low as to crucify the Saviour. Heaven has never been as hushed as to see their Hero mistreated so. But this is also the greatest day in the history of the world. There is now salvation provided for mankind. The forgiveness of sins is now available. There is now hope for sinners, the promise of heaven, a remedy for sin, and escape from hell.

There is an interesting thing to discover as you study your Bible. In God's dealings with mankind, at the great events of human history, God often performed clusters of miracles. The creation, the exodus from Egypt, the birth of and life of Christ - all were accompanied by a group of miracles. And now when Jesus would die at Calvary for our there sins there was again a group of supernatural miracles. It was as if nature itself was echoing the message of the cross.

The Miracle Of The Darkened Sun

27:45 – The Lord Jesus was crucified around 9:00 AM, which would be the 3rd hour according to the Jewish clock. At 12:00 Noon (the 6th hour) a darkness settled over all the land and it stayed dark until 3:00 that afternoon. This was not an eclipse of the sun. An eclipse occurs when the moon gets between the earth and the sun, but the longest eclipse lasts only about seven seconds. This darkness lasted for

three hours.

This was God's doings. It was God turning down the light of the sun. God just touched the sun and there was darkness and blackness everywhere. It was nature sympathizing with it's Maker. It was God wrapping a funeral drape around the cross of Calvary.

God was doing something that day at Calvary that no human eye was able to see. When God created the world He did it in the light, but when God did the work of redemption He did it in the dark. When God did His work of creation, he said, "Let there be light." But when God did His work of redemption, He said, "Let there be dark."

The cross is the divider between heaven and hell, and when Christ died on the cross He endured the darkness of Calvary so we could be saved from the darkness of hell. When Christ died, the Light of the world had essentially been snuffed out. God's appropriate response was to remove all sunlight as a symbol of the removal of the Sonlight.

The Miracle Of The Dismantled Sanctuary

27:51 – The veil was a barrier that kept people out of the Holy of Holies: it stood sixty feet high, was thirty feet wide and about one inch thick. There was only one man in Israel allowed to go behind that veil and into the Holy of Holies and that was the High Priest – and he was allowed to go in only once a year on the Day of Atonement.

The veil said stay out. Did you know that the great heroes of Jewish history had never been behind that veil and into the Holy of Holies? Moses had never been inside. Joseph had never been inside. David had never been inside. None of the prophets—Isaiah, Jeremiah—none of them had ever been in there. Jesus never went within that veil.

But the day Jesus died on the cross of Calvary, God supernaturally tore that veil in two from top to bottom. That miracle is telling us what the cross did for you and me. It is telling us that when Jesus died on the cross, the old was completed and the new was inaugurated. All of the sacrifices, all of the offerings, all of the pictures, ev-

erything that the Old Testament had portrayed was completed and fulfilled in the dying of the Lord Jesus on the cross of Calvary. When the body of Christ was sacrificed on the cross, the way was opened into the presence of God. No more need for temples and altars and sacrifices. No more need for priests to mediate between God and man. No more need for veiled compartments and bloody mercy-seats.

The Miracle Of The Demolished Sepulchres

27:51-53 – When Moses was on Mt. Sinai there was an earthquake as he received the Law. Now as the Lord is doing the work of grace on the cross, there is an earthquake. This is Calvary's answer to Sinai.

The earthquake was so intense that it broke up rocks and opened up graves. This is a testimony of the effect of Calvary on death. When Jesus died on that cross, it was not death defeating the Lord but the Lord defeating death. The death of Jesus Christ has made possible the forgiveness of sins, but it has also made possible that just as He rose from the dead we are going to be raised from the dead one of these days too.

The Miracle Of The Discerning Soldier

27:54 – A centurion was a military officer who had one hundred men under his command. He was an officer in the Roman army and was the commanding officer there. It was his men who were carrying out the crucifixion.

I do not know if this centurion got saved or not, but he is getting real close. You will never get saved without acknowledging the deity of Christ, and the centurion has just done that. I am going to imagine that he trusted Christ that day, just as the thief hanging next to Jesus did.

That's the greatest miracle of Calvary. It was a miracle when the darkness came. It was a miracle when the veil was torn. It was a miracle when the earth shook and the graves opened up. But the greatest miracle of all is when a soul turns from their sins and by faith invites Jesus into
