Everywhere we go, churches and individuals are interested in paper!


As of the present, GOD has ALREADY provided the funds for approximately 104 rolls of paper; that is 14 more than all of last year!

This year we have already been in eighteen states in these first five months. Great doors of utterance have been opened for us to go through, for the printing of God's word, and there are many adversaries and adversarial things to overcome. This year we have been blessed to add some new supporting churches for Victory Baptist Press and also have had a few churches commit to buying a roll of paper every month. GLORY! As much as we seek support and finances for paper for Bibles, we also covet prayer. Dee and I are more committed now, than ever, to the ministry of VBP!

I would ask that you begin to pray with us about another motor home. We currently have a 2003 forty-foot Fleetwood RV that has and continues to take care of us. However, it now has higher mileage, and the constancy of usage is taking a toll on her. This motor home is the only home Dee and I own. I am praying the Lord will help us get it paid off in the next year or so. We hope to purchase one a little larger, with the hopes it will be the last we will buy in our lifetime. This RV has taken us to areas to get over 240 rolls of paper since 2017. The next will be God's, just as this one is. Please pray.

My desire is that you do not see complaint from us in this letter, but to convey that what we do is spiritual. We MUST have God's power, and His smile upon our labors.
