

World War II (1941-1945) ended with the surrender of Japan on August 15,1945, by way of a public radio announcement.

General Douglas MacArthur led the US Military to join forces with the Philippines and accepted the signing of a full surrender of the Japanese military on the deck of the USS Missouri in Tokyo Bay on September 2, 1945, officially bringing the war to an end and liberating the Philippines from Japanese control.

For many years the Philippines has welcomed American missionaries, and many of them have responded and done some marvelous work among the Filipino people, and now it seems that a new door of opportunity has opened.

Through the ministry of Missionary Gerald Sutek, who has faithfully served in the Philippines for more than twenty years, there is now an open door for VBP to supply that country with our military edition Bibles, which are simply King James Bibles with a military-themed cover for the military bases.
