We would like to give a giant-sized THANK YOU to our wonderful Lord for raising up a company of like-minded Christians who through prayer and financial support have made it possible for VBP to work at sending the glorious Gospel of Christ around the world.

Print Shop News

The last container of Spanish Bibles shipped to missionary Don Rich arrived at his place in Cajamarca, Peru, on Saturday, November 1. Over the years, we have shipped eight containers to Brother Rich for a total of 195,000 Bibles, and they have been, or soon will all be, distributed into all nine Spanish-speaking countries in South America.

From the ones left over in the shop from that last shipment, several have been shipped to a chaplain at a prison in Texas for the Spanish-speaking inmates there, and several more have been shipped to churches here in the United States for use in their outreach to the Hispanic population in their communities, including 150 shipped to Bible Baptist Church, Deland, Florida, for their new work with Spanish-speaking individuals, and another 1,000 were delivered to Capitol City Baptist Church in Austin, Texas, to be divided among the missionaries they support.

The Largest Spoken Language in the World

Since English is now the largest spoken language in the world, and since **we believe the content of the original manuscripts of God's word is accurately and completely restated in the English language in the text of the King James Bible**, we rejoice in the opportunity to go through open doors with a language that we understand.

I don't mean to sound critical nor am I against those who have the education needed to translate and produce Scripture in other languages, but this writer has very little formal education. After being expelled from public school about halfway through the ninth grade, the future for me didn't look very promising. In my rebellion, I was a candidate for prison, sleeping under a bridge and on my way to Hell with no help or hope, but God had other plans. As an eighteen-year-old rebel, going down the wrong road just as fast as I could travel, the good Lord intervened and birthed me into His family. Not long after that He gave me the prettiest (and the smartest) girl in our community to be my wife. Mary and I have now enjoyed sixty-one years of a wonderful marriage and we have a good family of two daughters and one son that has now grown to a total of thirty-two people, with one more expected to show up any day now. They all attend Bible-believing, fundamental Baptist churches, and for the icing on the cake, God called me to preach and has given me a part in a ministry that by His good grace is reaching around the world with the Gospel of Christ in its purest form. Praise the Lord for His blessings on me!

The Gospel Is Reaching People for Less than 11 Cents Per Person

Using Mordecai's Method there have now been 3.2 million **Cards With The Cross** mailed to household addresses in communities all across America. According to the U.S. Census Bureau, there are approximately 2.61 people

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living in each household. At a cost of approximately 28 cents each for printing and mailing the cards, the glorious, soul-saving, life-changing Gospel of Christ has now been put into the homes of more than eight million people at less than 11 cents per person.

A good testimony comes from Pastor J. R. Trammell and the Harvest Hill Baptist Church in San Antonio, Texas. Brother Trammell says that for several years he had prayed for a way to get the Gospel into every home in their county. In 2020, when the call came from VBP explaining Mordecai's Method, he knew the Lord had provided a way. They chose to do their own mailing from their location, and so far VBP has supplied the cards and HHBC has mailed the Gospel to 669,241 household addresses in Bexar (pronounced Bear) county. Another 145 churches have also had the cards mailed on their behalf to every household address in their community.

John/ Romans Are in Great Demand.

In our last Newsletter we reported that the third shipment of John/Romans for missionary Josh Szwarga in New Zealand would be around 100,000 when finished. That number has now increased to 135,000 and should be finished and shipped within the next few weeks.

The Order Has Been Placed for the Next Load of Paper

Just as soon as the next load of paper arrives, the first printing project will be 5,000 English Bibles for Concord Baptist Church in Burnsville, North Carolina, to be used in their outreach to their local law enforcement. The remainder of that load of paper will be used to print Military Edition Bibles.

Military Edition Bibles

The Bibles for the military are simply King James Bibles with an added six-page article on *How to Be Saved Forever and Know It!* and a nine page article describing total consecration to Christ titled, *A Typical Life*. These Bibles will also have military-theme covers.

We had a few of these Bibles left over from our last printing so Brother Mike Hawkins in Anderson, South Carolina, recently got a shipment of 1,200 for work among the US veterans in his area. Also, few weeks ago Brother Bob Ashby and his wife Debbie from Anderson, South Carolina, drove down to Florida and picked up 600 of the Bibles for their work among the veterans.

The 1,000 military Bibles that were shipped to Missionary Gerald Sutek earlier in the year have been used on the Philippine military bases. The next printing will include 10,000 more for Brother Sutek to continue to use on the military outreach in his area.

We will then work toward two containers of 25,000 Bibles each for the Philippines, one for Cebu and the other for Mindanao. Pastor Michael Carpenter of Hamlet, North Carolina, has contacted two pastors there that he recommends, and they are excited about the possibility of receiving the much-needed Bibles.

What Can You Do to Help

Other than a very small amount of money from our online bookstore compared to what is needed, and since we make no charge for the Scriptures we print, our only hope for financing the rest of any project is that the Lord will lead others to include VBP in their missions giving. If you are not already a supporter of VBP, please pray that the good Lord will show you what He would have you to do to help. If He doesn't give you any answer, then don't do anything. We believe prayer to the God that doeth all things well and is able to supply our every need according to His riches in glory, will lead the ones that He would have support this ministry, so PLEASE PRAY!
