Greetings to all our friends and supporters,

#### **Changes in the Printshop**

When the lease on the Konica Minolta presses that we have used for several years ran out, we got a better lease price on Xerox printers, so we changed to Xerox. One of the Konica Minolta presses belonged to the lease company and one belonged to VBP. Since we had no more need for ours, Brother Bill Richburg arranged for it to be donated to Brother Bill Goins and the *Calvary Stand Printing Ministry* in Tunnel Hill, Georgia. A few years ago we donated a two-color sheet-fed press to Brother Rick Merriman in Spotsylvania, Virginia. Since we are now doing all of our color printing on the digital presses, we no longer use our Ryobi four-color press, so Brother Richburg has arranged for it to also go to Brother Merriman and his printing ministry. Both of these men have good ministries and will use these machines to print more, much-needed Christian literature. May the good Lord bless all they are doing by way of the printed page.

There has also been a change in the paper for the big web press. A new vender sent us two sample rolls of their paper for us to try. Brother Al Berg and Brother Daniel Kendrick did a trial run and both agree that the new paper is a good match for the web press. Even though the different paper is about the same price that we have been paying, it is supposed to yield a thirteen percent increase in the finished product. An order has been placed for our first full truckload, and it is scheduled for delivery on December, 22nd.

#### **Please Pray**

Now that we are printing more Bibles with custom designed paperback covers, we have decided to begin laminating them. It will not only improve the appearance, it will make them much more durable. In our last prayer letter we mentioned printing 5,000 English Bibles for Concord Baptist Church in Burnsville, North Carolina, to use with their outreach to the local law enforcement. The covers have already been designed and plans are to send them to a commercial printer for laminating. It would be very helpful to have a commercial grade laminating machine in the VBP printshop so please pray with us about this need!

More than fifty years ago, the late Dr. Harold Sightler preached his classic sermon from Psalm 78 entitled "God Can." There was no way he could have known how timely the message would be fifty years later, but when we look at the future plans for VBP, I see many human impossibilities. But, as I look back on the many years VBP has printed and shipped millions of Scripture portions to mission fields without charge to those who received them, I see a testimony that says, "God Can" do exceeding, abundantly above all that we ask or think, and that He will supply all our need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

Less than two weeks ago, Brother Gerald Sutek, missionary in the Philippines, said an officer from another military base drove eight hours to get his last forty military edition Bibles to give to cadets on his base. Brother Sutek then said "the Bibles open doors. I am out of Bibles."

With the doors that are opening on other military bases, we already have an opportunity to ship at least another 60,000 military edition Bibles to be distributed in the Philippine Islands, not counting the several thousand that we supply for the US military ministries each year. Can we make it happen? No, but <u>GOD CAN</u>, and as He has always done in the past, we expect Him to use faithful financial supporters to help carry the load.
